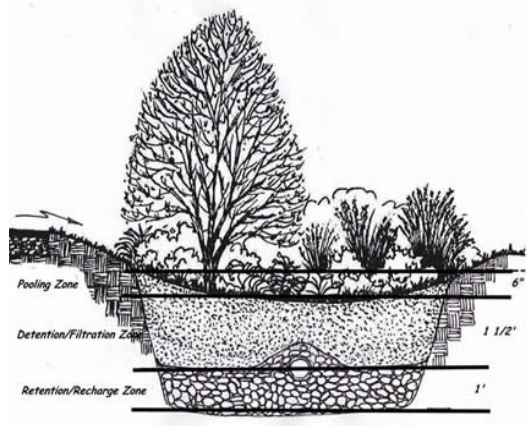
Rain Gardens & Salmon Safe Residential Development
